Conf. Championship Weekend

Sam Martin was a VERY IMPRESSIVE 4-1 ATS on Saturday and was 2-0 this weekend with 25* selections! He followed that up with an easy Monday Night Winner on the Saints!

It's Conference Championship Weekend in College Football and the final week of the regular season. That means a unique set of handicapping circumstances as you often find games taking place on neutral fields with a revenge angle in play. This season sees more Conference Championship Games than ever with the Big 10 and Pac 10 joining the fray. Here's what you need to know about the games taking place this week.

Up first is the MAC Conference Championship Game, pitting Northern Illinois against Ohio. The former is only a four-point favorite, which seems low. Since this game was moved to Ford Field in 2004, the West holds a 4-3 SU edge over the East Division. That includes a pair of losses by Ohio by an average of 15.5 PPG. However, last season saw Northern Illinois lose outright as 17-point favorites to Miami in this game! The underdog is 3-0 ATS L3 MAC Championships with two outright wins.

The inaugural Pac 12 Title game is almost a joke. Oregon is a 31-point favorite over UCLA, who just fired its coach. This game is in Eugene. You may want to consider playing the total instead, although

the Bruins are just 2-10 ATS as a road dog.

Saturday brings a quartet of conference championships. The first is in Conference USA with unbeaten Houston double digit chalk against a Southern Miss team that has two awful losses (Marshall, UAB) on its resume. This game will be played at Houston and these teams did not meet during the regular season. The East Division has won four straight (4-0 ATS), but that streak is unlikely to continue.

The SEC Title Game is usually the crown jewel of the weekend, but this year's may not matter as LSU probably does not need to win to advance to the BCS Title Game. They are double digit favorites over Georgia. The higher ranked team is 8-3 SU since 2000 and 10 of those 11 games have been decided by double digits.

The Big 10 and ACC Championship Games are very similar. The favorites are both playing with revenge for outright losses in the regular season. Virginia Tech has won three of the last four ACC Title tilts and is laying seven to a Clemson team that beat them 23-3 in the regular season. In the Big 10, Wisconsin has opened as 9.5-point chalk vs. Michigan State.

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Atlanta at Houston Sunday, Dec. 4th , 1:00 ET

For the first time in a month, the Falcons hit the road. They are off back to back home wins over Tennessee and Minnesota, pushing one game and covering by a ½ pt in the other. NFL teams playing their first road game after three straight at home are 5-2 ATS this season and here Atlanta is very fortunate to be catching a Houston team whose QB situation has become about as dire as any in the league.

The Texans have never made the playoffs in franchise history. With Peyton Manning out for the year, this looked to be their year as they started 7-3 to take control of the AFC South. This despite missing star WR Andre Johnson for five games. Johnson was expected to return after the bye and that's when disaster struck. It was announced QB Matt Schaub would be lost for the year and Matt Leinart would need to start in his place. Fortunately, the Texans got to play Jacksonville in their first game without Schaub, were off a bye, and won 20-13 as 6.5-point favorites.

But the SU/ATS win did not come without consequences. Leinart broke his collarbone and now he's lost for the year. This leaves third-stringer TJ Yates to man the ship down the stretch. Has Houston built a comfortable enough cushion to hold in the division? Not sure, but we don't like their chances here against an Atlanta team starting to spread its wings. **3* Atlanta.**

Denver at Minnesota Sunday, Dec. 4th, 1:00 ET

For the seventh straight week, Tim Tebow and Denver are an underdog. For the first six games it was justified. Not here. Since Tebow was named starter, the Broncos are 5-1 SU/ATS. Four of those wins have come by a TD or less. Here oddsmakers are a bit more careful as Denver has opened as a small one-point dog and the public will almost certainly bet them to the role of favorite by kickoff.

How can you bet against this Tebow right now? Was there any doubt they would come back and beat the Chargers last week? Now, for the first time, Denver has an opponent they can out and out dominate in the struggling Vikings. Minnesota is just 2-9, starting a rookie quarterback in Christian Ponder and has lost RB Adrian Peterson for an extended period of time. Bettors have to be livid with coach Leslie Frazier's decision not to go for the field goal late, down 24-14 as 9.5-point underdogs last week vs. Atlanta, as it cost them a likely cover. What can you say? When things are bad, things are bad.

We found a great system that says the Broncos are the play here. It says to play against any home team with a betting line of three points or less, if they've lost eight or more of their last 10 games, in Weeks 10 through 13. This system has produced a remarkable 24-3 ATS record or 89% winners! **3* Denver**

San Diego at Jacksonville Monday, Dec. 5th, 8:30 ET

If the Chargers lose this game, then Norv Turner needs to be fired immediately. He probably should be fired anyways. San Diego has fallen apart since a 4-1 start, losing six games in a row – both straight up and against the spread. This is pretty much the exact opposite of how every

other season has gone under Turner.

Jacksonville is getting way too much respect from the oddsmakers here, probably because of a 12-7 upset over Baltimore last month on Monday night. The Ravens were caught napping in that game and with the mood so dire now in San Diego, we have to think the Chargers are going to come away with a big win here. The Jaguars offense is just downright pathetic, having not scored more than 20 points in any game this season. They average 12.5 PPG, have no quarterback, and were crushed last year by the Lightning Bolts 38-13 on the West Coast. They also just fired Jack Del Rio as we went to press. Somehow, they have three wins. They will not make it four here. **5* San Diego**

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Georgia vs. LSU Saturday, Dec. 3rd, 4:00 ET

They say LSU doesn't even have to win this game to play for the BCS Championship in a likely rematch with Alabama. They also said LSU didn't need to beat Arkansas last Friday and they won that game by 24 points, outscoring the Hogs 41-3 after falling into an early 14-0 hole. The fact is simple. With the exception of Bama, who they did beat on the road, the Tigers are simply much better than every other team in the SEC and every other team in the country for that matter.

This fact is not lost on the oddsmakers for this year's SEC Championship against Georgia as LSU again finds itself as a double digit favorite. The Bulldogs started the year 0-2 and Mark Richt was on the hot seat in Athens, but UGA has since rattled off 10 consecutive victories to take the East Division. The East winner has been crushed in the previous two SEC Title games with Florida losing 32-13 as a favorite two years ago and South Carolina losing 56-17 to Auburn last season.

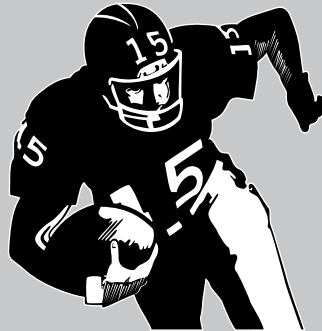
Upon closer inspection, Georgia's 10-game win streak was not as impressive as it sounds. They avoided the top three teams out of the West (LSU, Alabama, Arkansas) and their only three road SEC games came against Tennessee, Vandy and Ole Miss. They haven't left the "Peach State" this month and despite an impressive win last week at Georgia Tech, that doesn't change the fact that the Dawgs are 0-6 ATS their last six as an underdog (0-2 ATS this year). Yes, this game is in Atlanta, but the Tigers are just a much better team. LSU wins big. **5* LSU.**

Virginia Tech vs. Clemson Saturday, Dec. 3rd, 8:00 ET

This is one of two conference championship games on Saturday where the favorite will be playing with major revenge for a regular season defeat. In the case of the ACC, we have one-loss Virginia Tech favored by a touchdown over a rapidly fading

ing Clemson team that went to Blacksburg earlier in the year and handed the Hokies a 23-3 defeat.

Since that time, Clemson has been outright awful. Well, they did win and cover their next three games, but since that time is 1-3 SU and 0-4 ATS. Every loss has come by at least two touchdowns and their only win over the last month came over Wake Forest, a game they trailed heading into the fourth quarter as 16.5-point chalk.

The Hokies have been an excellent revenge team under Frank Beamer, going 30-10-2 ATS against conference foes, including 23-4-2 ATS when NOT laying double digits, according to Vegas Expert Marc Lawrence. The Tigers were 0-5 SU/ATS vs. Virginia Tech before that win earlier this season and there is no doubt in our minds who is the better team right now. **3* Virginia Tech**

Michigan State vs. Wisconsin Saturday, Dec. 3rd, 8:15 ET

The Big 10 has joined the Conference Championship fray this season with the laughable Legends and Leaders Divisions, but the fact is we have a title game pitting the two best teams against one another. Again, this is a case of a favorite playing with revenge for the regular season. We all remember October 22nd in East Lan-

cing when Michigan State completed a Hail Mary at the end of the game to pull out the 37-31 outright win.

Following that loss, Wisconsin lost again on a Hail Mary to Ohio State, but has since rattled off four straight wins by an average margin of 30.75 PPG. This includes destroying Penn State last week 45-7 in Madison to clinch the Leaders Division title. Despite that average margin of victory, however, the Badgers are just 2-2 ATS in those games.

Wisconsin may very well win this game, but not by the margin the oddsmakers are calling for here. Michigan State has beaten the Badgers each of the last two seasons (Wisconsin is 21-2 SU otherwise) and is also playing very sound football, covering seven of their last nine games. They did a very good job not looking ahead to this game, beating Northwestern last week, 31-17, on the road. **3* Michigan State.**

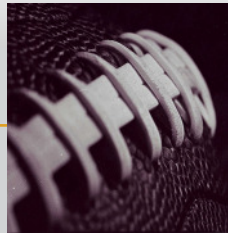
Cincinnati at Pittsburgh

Cincinnati's seven victories have come against Cleveland (2), Buffalo, Indianapolis, Jacksonville, Tennessee and Seattle. Of those teams, only 6-5 Tennessee has a winning record. These teams met just three weeks ago in Cincinnati and the Steelers came away with a 24-17 win and cover as 3-point road favorites. It was Pittsburgh's third straight win in this rivalry. The Steelers are off a sluggish showing Sunday night, but have shown great bounce back ability in the past at 9-2 ATS off an ATS loss.

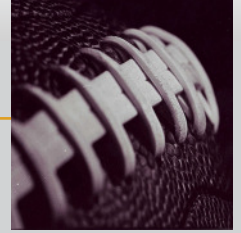
Oklahoma at Oklahoma State

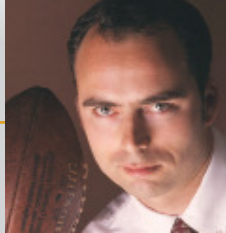


Kansas City at Chicago

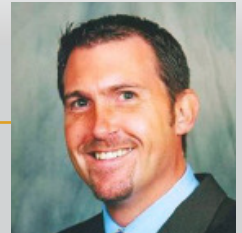


New Mexico at Boise State

Despite failing to cover last time out, the Broncos are still a profitable 14-8-2 ATS the last 24 times that they were favored by 31 or more points. Given their recent "slide," and with this being their last regular season game, I feel the Broncos will be motivated to "keep the pedal to the metal" the entire way.

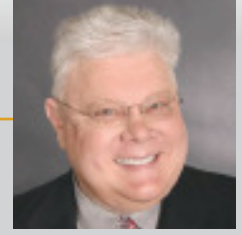


Indianapolis at New England

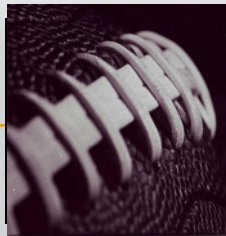
Duke at North Carolina

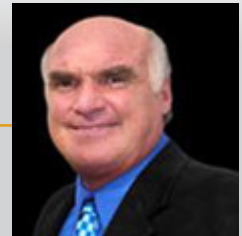
Texas at Baylor
